

Intersection improvements on Elouera Road and Kingsway, Cronulla

The widening of Elouera Road will help reduce congestion and improve journey times for road users

The NSW Government is funding the project as part of its \$100 million Congestion and Safety Program.

On 1 September 2019, work will begin to widen Elouera Road on the approach to its intersection with Kingsway. The work will add a new right turn only lane to allow more vehicles through the intersection with each traffic light phase, improving journey times. This will reduce queuing time for road users travelling along Elouera Road into Gerrale Street.

The widening will also allow for a dedicated cycle-lane through the intersection, which will link to Sutherland Shire Council's existing cycle routes on Elouera Road and Gerrale Street.

Work to date

Work on the project began in December 2018, with the establishment of two disability parking spaces to replace spaces in the work area. It also saw the construction of a safer pram ramp onto the pedestrian crossing over Elouera Road.

Work in Peryman Square

As part of the project, we're rebuilding the intersection's drainage infrastructure. To do this, we will excavate along a narrow line through Peryman Square, putting new concrete pipes in place as we go. The work won't affect access to the Square's shops, cafés and restaurants.

The Bali Memorial in Peryman Square

Our work will not disturb or affect access to the Bali Memorial. People will be able to visit the Memorial while the project is underway.

What happens next?

We'll soon start work to widen Elouera Road on its approach to the intersection. Once the road is widened, it'll be resurfaced and the new turning lane and the clearly-marked cycle lane will be established and utilities will be upgraded.

How will the work affect you?

Our work may be noisy at times but we will do everything we can to minimise its impact, including completing the noisier activities, such as concrete cutting, chainsawing and jackhammering, by midnight.

Traffic changes

There will be temporary traffic changes during our work hours, which may affect travel times. Please keep to speed limits and follow signs and traffic controllers' directions. For the latest traffic updates, you can call 132 701, visit livetraffic.com or download the Live Traffic NSW App.

Our work schedule

Between 1 September and the end of December 2019, we'll be on site up to six days a week for 40 shifts from Monday to Friday, between 7am and 6pm, and between 8am and 1pm on Saturdays.

We will also work up to five nights a week for 60 shifts, between 8pm and 5am from Sunday to Thursday. We will not work on public holidays.

Changes to parking arrangements

There will be temporary parking restrictions on Elouera Road during our work hours to allow it to be completed safely. There will also be a temporary reduction in the number of spaces in the public carpark at the intersection of Mitchell Road, Prince Street and Bando Road, due to the establishment of the site compound.

Temporary site compound

Under an agreement with Sutherland Shire Council, we'll be establishing a temporary site compound in the public carpark at the intersection of Mitchell Road, Prince Street and Bando Road. The compound mainly will be used to store machinery and materials and may be in use any time work is taking place on Elouera Road. We have made the compound as small as possible to minimise disruption to parking. The compound will be removed as soon as the project is complete.
