## **Night work and extended weekend hours on Tourle Street and Cormorant Road, Kooragang, from Wednesday 6 December 2017**

**The Australian and NSW governments have each committed funding for this project to improve traffic flow and cater for future traffic growth.**

Roads and Maritime Services has engaged WBHO McIlwain Joint Venture to duplicate 3.8 kilometres of Tourle Street and Cormorant Road between Industrial Drive, Mayfield West and Egret Street, Kooragang, including the construction of a second bridge over the Hunter River.

Upcoming work includes:

- temporary line marking for changed traffic conditions
- installing median safety barriers
- installing wire rope safety barriers
- bridge construction including concrete deck pours
- delivery of concrete for bridge deck pours on Tourle Street and Cormorant Road
- road construction and surfacing activities on Tourle Street and Cormorant Road
- utilities, drainage and concreting activities on Tourle Street and Cormorant Road.

To minimise traffic disruptions, some of the work will be carried out at night and outside standard working hours.

Night work will be carried out occasionally between **6pm** and **7am**, from **Wednesday 6 December** and **continue for two months**, weather permitting.

We will be working extended weekend hours between **7am** and **6pm** from **Wednesday 6 December** to **Wednesday 31 January 2018**, weather permitting.

**No work will be carried out between Friday 22 December 2017 and Sunday 7 January 2018 inclusive.**

We will continue to deliver the majority of work between **7am** and **6pm**, from **Monday** to **Friday**, weather permitting.

Minor work will be carried out on the new bridge but this will not impact traffic.

## How will the work affect you?

There will be some noise associated with this work. We will make every effort to minimise noise by:

- arranging the work in stages at different locations
- using the minimum amount of machinery necessary and turning off the machinery when not in use
- monitoring worker behaviour to ensure noise is kept to a minimum.

## Traffic changes

Temporary traffic changes will continue to be in place to ensure the work area is safe.
