

# Linden Street upgrade

## Project update | December 2022

Transport for NSW is upgrading Linden Street to reduce congestion and improve safety, traffic flow and journey reliability.

#### What's happening?

#### Temporary closure of the Linden Street bus stop

A temporary closure of the Linden Street bus stop (ID 2232130) will be in place from **Monday 9 January until late-March 2023**, weather permitting. During the closure, work will include removing and rebuilding the existing shelter, footpath and foundation.

During the temporary closure, customers can use the existing bus stops on Linden Street and Leonay Street. More information about routes and the alternative bus stops will be displayed at the bus shelter ahead of this temporary closure.

We thank you for your patience during this work.

#### Other work on the project

During December and January, work will also include:

- Continuing with the removal of concrete medians
- Continuing with the relocation of utilities
- Installing temporary safety barriers, signage and traffic signals
- Removing existing kerb, footpaths, linemarking and pavement to widen the road
- Installing drainage
- Building new road pavement and kerb, including transporting material and equipment, pouring concrete, placing and compacting pavement.

The site will be closed over the upcoming holiday period from **Thursday 22 December** until **Monday 9 January 2023**. During this time, you can contact us on **1800 708 727** for site emergencies.

### How will the work impact me?

This work may be noisy at times. Equipment used may include lights, vehicles and trucks, generators, excavators, vacuum trucks and water carts, powered hand tools and lighting towers.

We will make every effort to minimise disruption by:

- Fitting equipment with devices to minimise noise, including reversing squawkers rather than beepers
- Using noise shields
- Turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use

- Directing temporary lighting down and away from homes
- Carrying out noisier activities, including jackhammering and saw cutting, earlier in the night, where possible
- Monitoring noise to manage impacts and adjust our work, where possible.

#### **Working hours**

Day work is carried out between **7am and 6pm Monday to Friday**, and between **8am and 1pm Saturday**.

Night work is carried out between 8pm and 5am Sunday to Thursday.

#### Traffic and pedestrian changes

Temporary safety barriers will be installed, and a reduced speed limit of 40km/h will be in place to allow work to be carried out safely on the project.

Traffic changes when work is occurring may also include temporary lane and shoulder closures and intermittent stop/slow traffic control. Please observe traffic signs and traffic controllers' directions.

A pedestrian detour is in place until the new Galga Street cul-de-sac is built. Pedestrians can use the existing signalised crossings and footpaths on Linden Street, Leonay Street and Oakwood Street to join the footpath on River Road. Signage is in place to guide pedestrians.
