M1 Pacific Motorway upgrade between Kariong and Somersby – construction noise impact assessment for early work

The Australian and NSW Governments are funding an upgrade of the M1 Pacific Motorway between the Kariong and Somersby interchanges. The proposed upgrade involves widening the motorway and upgrading three of the four ramps at the Kariong interchange to improve traffic flow and safety.

To prepare for the upgrade, Roads and Maritime Services will soon carry out repairs to the existing concrete road surface on the M1 Pacific Motorway between the Kariong and Somersby interchanges.

The concrete repairs need to be completed in preparation for major construction expected to start in 2017.

To minimise traffic disruptions, the early work will be carried out at night from June to October 2016, weather permitting.

How will the work affect you?

We are currently carrying out a construction noise impact assessment in areas close to the M1 Pacific Motorway. This assessment will investigate whether nearby properties will be impacted by construction noise from the early work.

What happens next?

We will let you know if your property is expected to be impacted by construction noise during early work and discuss the proposed measures to minimise noise. We will provide more information about timing for the early work in advance of work starting.
