Early work for the M1 Pacific Motorway upgrade between Tuggerah and Doyalson interchanges from Tuesday 29 March 2016

The Australian and NSW governments are funding the upgrade of the M1 Pacific Motorway between the Tuggerah and Doyalson interchanges to improve traffic flow and safety.

To prepare for the upgrade, Roads and Maritime Services is building a site compound on the corner of Hue Hue and St Johns roads at Jilliby in advance of major construction. The site is temporary and will be operational until mid 2020.

We will be working **Monday to Friday** between **7am and 6pm** and **Saturday** between **8am and 1pm**. We expect to complete early work by the end of July 2016, weather permitting. We will let you know in advance if we need to do any work outside these times.

The early work involves building temporary fencing and driveways, vegetation removal and the installation of a temporary road base within the site.

Major construction is due to start in late 2016. We will provide more information to residents and stakeholders about construction as the project progresses.

How will the work affect you?

We will make every effort to minimise noise and dust. Where possible, obstructions to driveways will be minimised.

Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes to make sure the work zone is safe. Temporary reduced speed limits and traffic control may be in place on Hue Hue and St Johns roads.
