# M12 Motorway early works

## March 2022

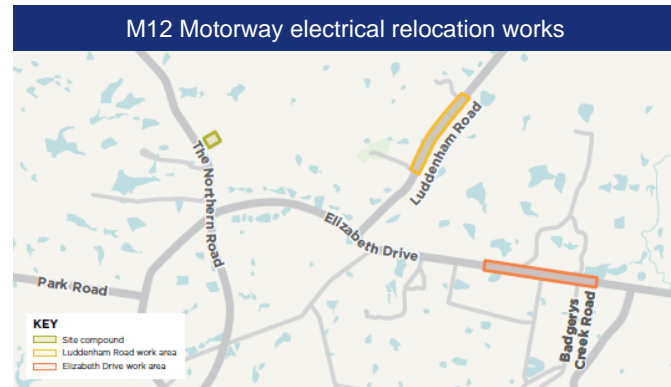
The Australian and NSW governments are building the M12 Motorway to provide a direct access to the Western Sydney International Airport and connection to Sydney's motorway network.

## What are we doing?

Transport for NSW has contracted Ausconnex to relocate the electrical network along Elizabeth Drive and Luddenham Road in Badgerys Creek, as part of its early works program.

Work commenced in late 2021 and is expected to continue for up to another three months.

Work will take place from Monday to Friday, 7am to 6pm, and on Saturdays from 8am to 6pm. If work is required outside these times further information will be provided.

## How will this work affect you?

During this work, there may be speed reduction, lane closures and stop-go arrangements in place along sections of Elizabeth Drive and Luddenham Road. Access for local residents will be maintained during the works, however residents may experience some delays so please allow extra travel time.

The work will involve motorised plant and equipment, and some light vehicles.
