

## M12 Motorway investigation work from 24 May 2021

The Australian and NSW governments are building the M12 Motorway to provide direct access to the Western Sydney International Airport at Badgerys Creek and connection to Sydney's motorway network.

Transport for NSW is continuing work on the detailed design for the M12 Motorway. We need to carry out utility investigation work along sections of Elizabeth Drive, Cecil Road and Wallgrove Road, Cecil Hills from **Monday 24 May**. This includes some night work which will start from **Tuesday 1 June**.

The investigation work will involve a hydraulic vacuum truck using high pressured water to soften the dirt so it can be gently sucked out revealing what utilities lie beneath the ground in several locations, marked on the included maps. The truck will either create a pothole to expose a single utility or a slit trench to expose multiple utilities.

### How will the work affect you?

We will be on site between **Monday 24 May and Thursday 24 June**, weather permitting, and will work up to five days each week for the duration of the work. Our daytime work hours are **7am to 6pm Monday to Friday**.

We will work nine night shifts, each starting at **6pm** and finishing by **midnight, Sunday to Thursday**. A night shift will not follow a day shift in the same location. Night shifts will be limited to four consecutive nights in the same location. To minimise our impact to the surrounding residents we will work to complete the noisier activities (i.e. saw cutting, using a vacuum truck) before midnight.

Machinery used may include lighting towers, track mounted drilling rigs, generator, vacuum truck and hand tools. Lighting towers will be positioned away from homes.
