

M12 Motorway Early Works – Tree Clearing for a New Temporary Roundabout on Elizabeth Drive, Badgerys Creek

Transport for NSW is building a temporary roundabout on Elizabeth Drive in Badgerys Creek, as part of its early works program.

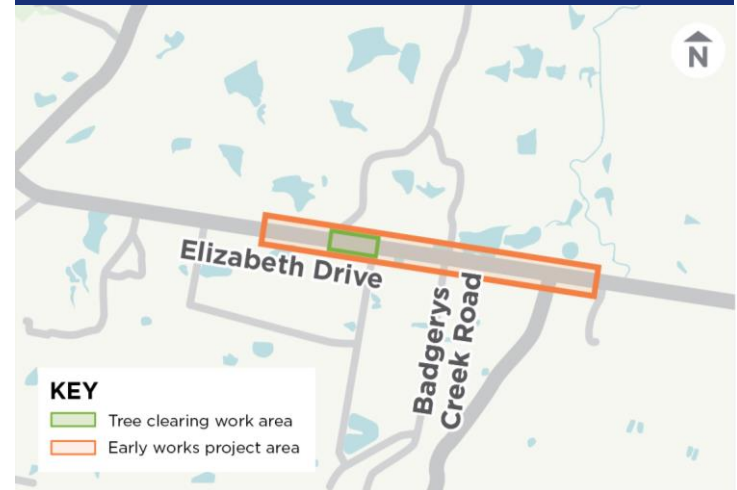
To facilitate this work, we need to remove some vegetation in the construction area located along Elizabeth Drive near the Taylors Road intersection.

This work will include the clearing of trees, bushes, and shrubs. See map for further detail on the location of this work.

The vegetation removal work will take place on **Monday 6 December** and **Tuesday 7 December 2021** (weather permitting) with Wednesday 8 December 2021 as a contingency date.

Due to the close proximity of this work to Elizabeth Drive, vegetation removal work will take place at night between **7pm** and **5am** when traffic volumes are lower.

How will the work affect you?

During this work, there will be speed reduction and traffic lane closures in place on Elizabeth Drive from the intersection of Taylors Road to approximately 400m to the west.

Access for local residents will be maintained during the works, however residents may experience some delays so please allow extra travel time.

The noise associated with these activities is not expected to impact residents.

The work will involve the use of chainsaws, excavators, lighting towers and some light vehicles.
