

M12 Motorway - West

Night work on Elizabeth Drive to install water main



The Australian and NSW governments are building the M12 Motorway to provide direct access to the Western Sydney International Airport at Badgerys Creek and connect to Sydney's motorway network.

What are we doing?

Transport for NSW will continue work to install a new underground water main as part of the M12 Motorway project.

From **Tuesday 6 September 2022** at the Elizabeth Drive and Badgerys Creek Road intersection, Badgerys Creek, we will:

- dig a tunnel and install pipes under the road with a tunnel boring machine
- remove construction material for disposal off site
- backfill and restore the impacted area.

We need to do this work at night to lessen traffic disruption and protect our workers and the public on these busy roads.

Our work schedule

From **Tuesday 6 September** and **Sunday 13 November 2022** we will be working up to 6 days a week. Our work hours are **Monday to Friday** between **6am** and **11pm** and between **6am** to **6pm** on **Saturdays**.

What equipment will be used?

During this work we will use tunnel boring machines, excavators, generators, light and heavy vehicles, lighting towers and hand tools.

How will this work affect you?

During the works you will see and increase presence of workers and equipment on the eastern and western side of the Elizabeth Drive and Badgerys Creek Road intersection.
