

M12 Motorway - West Bridge and night work on Elizabeth Drive



The Australian and NSW governments are building the M12 Motorway to provide direct access to the Western Sydney International Airport at Badgerys Creek and connect to Sydney's motorway network.

Major construction on the West section of the M12 Motorway continues.

From **Monday 19 September 2022** we will start building the new Elizabeth Drive bridge over the new Airport Access Road. During this work we will:

- remove trees, vegetation and topsoil to level the work zone
- drill, bore underground and pour concrete to establish bridge foundations (piling works)
- identify and relocate underground utility services.

We will work up to **six days a week** for **12 weeks** between **7am** and **6pm, Monday to Friday** and between **8am** and **1pm on Saturdays**, weather permitting. There will be no work on Sundays or public holidays.

Night work

Over **15 night shifts** between **Monday 26 September** and **Monday 31 October** we will work along Elizabeth Drive east of Luddenham Road to Badgerys Creek Road in Badgerys Creek to:

- carry out line marking and vegetation removal
- install temporary traffic barriers on Elizabeth Drive
- deliver equipment required for bridge works
- drill, bore underground and pour concrete to establish bridge foundations (piling works).

Our night work hours are between **7pm** and **6am, Monday to Friday**. These works need to be carried out at night for the safety of our workers and motorists and to minimise traffic disruption.

What equipment will be used?

During the piling work we will use piling rigs, delivery trucks, vacuum trucks, mobile cranes, asphalt paver, light vehicles, concrete trucks, excavators, tipper trucks, graders, compaction rollers, saw cutting tools, a compressor and handheld jackhammer to perform the work activities.

During the night work we will use a pressure washer or equivalent (for linemarking removal), water truck, line marker, small crane, flatbed trucks, excavator, light vehicles, small tools, vacuum truck, light towers and generators and a piling rig to perform the work activities.

How will this work affect you?

During these works you may see and hear increased activity in the area.

The night work may be noisy at times, but we will do everything we can to minimise its impact, including:

- completing noisier activities before **11pm**, where possible
- turning off equipment and machinery when not in use
- not working more than two nights in a row and three nights in the same week at the same location.



Traffic changes

There will be temporary traffic changes along the work zone during our work hours to ensure the work zone is safe.
