

M12 Motorway - West Night and weekend work on Elizabeth Drive Badgerys Creek



The Australian and NSW governments are building the M12 Motorway to provide direct access to the Western Sydney International Airport at Badgerys Creek and connect to Sydney's motorway network.

What are we doing?

For **20 night shifts** between **Monday 31 October** and **Wednesday 30 November** we will work along Elizabeth Drive east of Luddenham Road to Badgerys Creek Road in Badgerys Creek to:

- deliver, use and remove piling equipment required for bridge work
- carry out line marking
- vegetation removal
- install temporary traffic barriers on Elizabeth Drive
- deliver spoil and equipment to the site compound at Elizabeth Drive.

On **Saturday 20 November** and **Sunday 21 November** bridge piling work will also take place within the construction zone at Elizabeth Drive near the new Airport Access Road in Badgerys Creek.

We will work at night and on the weekend for the safety of our workers and motorists and minimise traffic disruption.

Work hours

Our weekend work hours are from **7am** to **6pm**. Our night work hours are between **7pm** and **6am**. We will not work more than two nights in a row and three nights in the same week in the same location.

What equipment will be used?

During the bridge piling work we will use a piling rig, crane, concrete pump, delivery trucks, traffic control and lighting towers. During the road works we may use delivery trucks, lighting towers, vacuum trucks, mobile cranes, asphalt paver, light vehicles, concrete trucks, excavators, tipper trucks, graders, compaction rollers, traffic control, saw cutting tools, a compressor and handheld jackhammer to perform the work activities.

We will use delivery trucks, light vehicles, grader, water cart, compactor, rollers and lighting towers during the spoil and equipment delivery.

How will this work affect you?

During our works you may see increased activities in the area. The work can be noisy at times, but we will do everything we can to minimise its impact, including completing noisier activities earlier in the night before **11pm**, where possible, and turning off equipment and machinery when not in use.

Traffic changes

There will be temporary traffic changes along the work zone during our work hours to ensure the work zone and traffic are safe while the equipment is used, delivered and removed.
