Work continues on M4 Roper Road westbound on-ramp Project

Transport for NSW | February 2022

The NSW Government is funding this project to ease congestion on the M4 Motorway on ramps and local roads within Erskine Park and St Clair.

We are well underway with early works, in preparation for the main work of the project which will commence in early 2022. From mid-February 2022, weather permitting, we will:

- relocate cameras monitoring M4 traffic and the emergency phone
- clear vegetation along Erskine Park Road and M4 Motorway (night work) commence drainage work along the project alignment
- continue earthwork in proposed work areas reshaping of the area to make room for the Erskine Park Road intersection widening and to commence construction of the new ramp and lane merge
- establish traffic management control devices
- carry out utility adjustments.

Our work schedule

Work during the day will occur on weekdays between 7am to 6pm and Saturdays between 7am to 6pm. During February, we will have night work between 8pm to 5am to clear vegetation along Erskine Park Road and the M4 Motorway. This work will take three nights to complete. We shall notify the impacted residents closer to the start of work.

How will the work affect you?

There may be some disruption associated with this work including vehicle movements during the use of this compound facility and surrounding areas. There will be some noisy work associated with the night work, we will use chainsaws to cut down the vegetation however use of the chainsaws will cease at midnight.

We will make every effort to minimise impact to the local community and motorists in the area. Access will be maintained at all times for local residents, should there be a need to limit access at any time, residents will be notified in advance.

Traffic changes

During the work there will be an increase in vehicle movements in and around the local streets however these will only be light vehicles and deliveries. Heavy vehicles will go directly to the work site areas only.

There may be some temporary lane closures during this work, we will notify residents and motorists closer to the date. During the night work there will be some temporary lane closures along Erskine Park Road and M4 Motorway.
