Reduced speed limit and continuing work on M4 Roper Road westbound on-ramp

Transport for NSW/ July 2022

The NSW Government is funding this project to ease congestion on the M4 Motorway on ramps and local roads within Erskine Park and St Clair.

Work is continuing on the M4 Roper Road westbound on ramp and over the following eight weeks work will include:

- safety barrier installation along the M4 Motorway westbound shoulder to enable continuation of earthworks, drainage and ramp construction
- bridge abutment and pier protection structure works under existing Roper Road bridge
- retaining wall construction around the g-loop
- utility and service installation and adjustments at the intersection at Erskine Park Road and M4 westbound off-ramp
- M4 westbound shoulder drainage work (out of hours work)
- pavement investigations work along northbound and southbound of Erskine Park Road (out of hours work)
- Erskine Park Road median drainage work (out of hours work)
- median island construction, widening work and pavement construction on Erskine Park Road (out of hours work)

Our work schedule

Our standard work hours are **Monday to Friday** from **7am to 6pm** and **Saturday** from **8am to 1pm**. No work will take place on Sunday or public holidays.

Out of hours work

As part of the M4 Roper Road westbound on-ramp project, out of hours is required between **8pm Sunday 3 July** and **5am Friday 26 August 2022.** We will work up to 5 nights per week, weather permitting. We will notify impacted residents prior to any out of hours work taking place.

How this work will affect you

We need to carry out this work at night to minimise traffic disruption and reduce safety risks to the workers and road users. There will be some impacts to residents and road users during this work.

The **out of hours work** will be noisy, however we will make every effort to minimise the impact for residents by carrying out noisier work before midnight, turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use and directing lights and noisy equipment away from properties where possible.

Equipment used may include road saw, vac truck, excavator, roller, trucks, profiler, asphalt machine, roller light vehicles and lighting towers.

Traffic Changes

As from 5am Tuesday 5 July 2022 until end of January 2023 there will be a new speed zone implemented from 110km/hr to 80km/hr on the westbound side of the M4 Westbound Motorway from Archbold Road Bridge to the gantry structure before Bennett Road Bridge. Shoulder closure on the M4 Westbound Motorway will take place from the Roper Road Bridge adjacent to the construction works. (See map below with speed reduction area)

During the work there will be an increase in vehicle movements in and around the local streets however these will only be light vehicles and deliveries. Heavy vehicles will go directly to the work site areas only. There may be some temporary lane closures during this work. We will notify residents and road users closer to the date if these are required.
