


56 hour closure of M4 Roper Road westbound off ramp from Friday 18 November

Transport for NSW/ November 2022

The NSW Government is funding this project to ease congestion on the M4 Motorway on ramps and local roads within Erskine Park and St Clair.

Transport for NSW is continuing work to construct the M4 Roper Road westbound on ramp. As part of this project, a temporary weekend closure of the M4 westbound off ramp is required to facilitate the construction of median islands, road widening, installation of utility crossings and guardrails.



The M4 Roper Road westbound off ramp will be closed from **8pm Friday 18 November to 4am Monday 21 November 2022**, weather permitting. We will also carry out lane closures on Erskine Park Road during this period. Should this work not proceed as scheduled, work will take place the following weekend from 8pm Friday 25 November to 4am Monday 28 November 2022, weather permitting.

Traffic changes and detour

Traffic control and electronic signage will be in place to ensure the work zone is safe for workers and road users as we temporarily close the M4 Roper Road westbound off ramp.

To minimise traffic disruption, road users will be redirected to the M4 Mamre Road westbound off ramp (see map). There will be additional lane closures on Erskine Park Road northbound and southbound. Road users are encouraged to plan ahead for the detour that will be in place.

Following this temporary closure, we will continue to carry out night work in this location up to five nights a week as required.

How this work will affect you

During this work you may experience some noise from our construction activity, however we will make every effort to minimise the impact for residents by turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use and directing lights and noisy equipment away from properties where possible.

The project team will use a variety of equipment to carry out this work including a road saw, vac truck, excavator, roller, paver, concrete trucks, jack hammer, elevated work platform, light vehicles and lighting towers.
