

Work continues on M4 Roper Road westbound on-ramp

Transport for NSW | December 2022

The NSW Government is working to ease congestion on the M4 Motorway on-ramps and local roads within Erskine Park and St Clair

During 2022, we:

- completed gas relocation work
- completed drainage works in the median of Erskine Park Road
- constructed a retaining wall to stabilise the existing bridge abutment
- built a cantilever retaining wall which will carry the future on-ramp
- reconstructed road pavement on the right turn lane of the M4 Roper Road off-ramp
- placed first asphalt layers during the 56-hour M4 Roper Road off-ramp closure.

What are we doing next?

Work will continue on the M4 Roper Road westbound on-ramp in 2023 to:

- complete asphalt layers on the M4 westbound shoulder and new westbound on-ramp
- reconstruct road pavement and upgrade traffic signals on Erskine Park Road
- install new electrical services, signage, safety features and smart motorway infrastructure
- continue landscaping in completed work areas.



Our work schedule

Our standard work hours are **Monday to Friday** from **7am to 6pm** and **Saturday** from **7am to 4pm**. We will not work on public holidays.

As part of the M4 Roper Road westbound on-ramp project, night work is required between **8pm Monday 9 January** and **5am Friday 3 March 2023**. We will work up to five nights per week, weather permitting. Sunday day works may be required to account for potential weather-related delays.

We will be off-site from Wednesday 21 December 2022 and will return to work Monday 9 January 2023.

How will the work affect you?

Work will be carried out at night to minimise traffic disruption and reduce safety risks to the workers and road users. Some of our activities may be noisy at times, we will do everything we can to minimise disruption by carrying out noisier work before midnight and turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use.

Equipment used may include road saw, vac truck, excavator, pilling rig, roller, trucks, profiler, asphalt machine, light vehicles and lighting towers.

Traffic changes

During this work there will be some temporary lane closures and changes to traffic conditions. We will notify residents and road users closer to the times via VMS signage along the motorway and roadways.
