

Continuation of work on M4 Roper Road westbound on-ramp

Transport for NSW/ August 2022

The NSW Government is funding this project to ease congestion on the M4 Motorway on ramps and local roads within Erskine Park and St Clair.

Work is continuing on the M4 Roper Road westbound on ramp and over the following eight weeks work will include:

- bridge abutment and pier protection structure works under existing Roper Road bridge
- retaining wall construction around the g-loop
- utility and service installation and adjustments at the intersection at Erskine Park Road, Roper Road eastbound on-ramp, Shepherd Street and M4 westbound off-ramp
- M4 westbound shoulder drainage work (out of hours work)
- pavement construction on the M4 westbound shoulder (out of hours work)
- Erskine Park Road median drainage work (out of hours work)
- median island construction, widening work and pavement construction on Erskine Park Road (out of hours work)
- signage installation along Erskine Park Road northbound, Shepherd Street and the M4 westbound shoulder.
- landscaping work along M4 westbound shoulder and Erskine Park Road.



Our work schedule

Our standard work hours are **Monday to Friday** from **7am to 6pm** and **Saturday** from **8am to 1pm**. No work will take place on public holidays.

Out of hours work

Night work is required between **8pm Sunday 28 August** and **5am Friday 21 October 2022**. We will work up to five nights per week, weather permitting. We will notify impacted residents prior to any out of hours work taking place.

How this work will affect you

We need to carry out this work at night to minimise traffic disruption and reduce safety risks to the workers and road users.

The **out of hours work** will be noisy, however we will make every effort to minimise the impact for residents by carrying out noisier work before midnight, turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use and directing lights away from properties where possible.

Equipment used may include road saw, vac truck, excavator, pilling rig, roller, trucks, profiler, asphalt machine, light vehicles and lighting towers.

Traffic Changes

The new speed zone from **110km/hr to 80km/hr** on the westbound side of the **M4 Westbound Motorway from Archbold Road Bridge to the gantry structure before Bennett Road Bridge** will remain in place **until end of January 2023**. Shoulder closure on the M4 Westbound Motorway will remain in place from the Roper Road Westbound Off-ramp to the construction works extent.
