How will our work affect you?

We need to carry out our work at night to minimise traffic disruption and reduce safety risks to the workers and motorists.

Equipment used may include road saw, vac truck, excavator, roller, crane, light vehicles and lighting towers.

There may be some slight noise during this work, however we will aim to minimise noise where possible and ensure we turn off equipment and vehicles when not in use.

Traffic changes

Temporary lane closures will take place on several nights on M4 Motorway (westbound slow lane), Roper Road off-ramp and Erskine Park Road, weather permitting.

The closures will ensure the work zone is safe for workers and road users. These will be managed with traffic control. Residents and motorists will be advised by VMS signage closer to the date.
