

Work continues on M4 Roper Road westbound on-ramp

Transport for NSW/ May 2022

The NSW Government is funding this project to ease congestion on the M4 Motorway on ramps and local roads within Erskine Park and St Clair.

Early works on this project have been completed. The next stage of the project is now getting underway and will continue for 12 weeks.

Work in the new stage will include:

- Earthwork in proposed work area – reshaping of the area to make room for the Erskine Park Road intersection widening and to commence construction of the new ramp and lane
- establish barriers on M4 Motorway (out of hours work)
- utility and service installation and adjustments – intersection at Erskine Park Road and M4 Westbound off-ramp
- retaining wall construction – M4 Motorway
- median and widening work along Erskine Park Road as well as pavement construction within the work area
- M4 Westbound shoulder drainage work (out of hours work)



Our work schedule

Our standard work hours are **Monday to Friday from 7am to 6pm** and **Saturday from 8am to 1pm**.

Out of hours work hours will be between **Monday to Friday from 8pm to 6am**. We will notify impacted residents prior to any out of hour's work taking place.

Out of hour's work

As part of the M4 Roper Road westbound on-ramp project, out of hours is required between **8pm Friday 20 May** and **7am Saturday 21 May 2022, weather permitting**. Should the work not take place on these dates: we will conduct this work on the following weekend of Friday 27 May to Saturday 28 May 2022, weather permitting.

Our work includes:

- temporary full closure of M4 Westbound off-ramp
- removal of existing drainage line and replacement with new drainage line
- removal of existing pavement and temporary pavement installation

Out of hours work will continue between **23 May to 1 July 2022**, weather permitting.

This work will include:

- continuation of drainage work along the M4 Motorway and Westbound off-ramp
- barrier installation on western and eastern side shoulders of M4 Motorway.

How this work will affect you

We need to carry out this work at night to minimise traffic disruption and reduce safety risks to the workers and road users. There will be some impacts to residents and road users during this work.

The **out of hours work** will be noisy, however we will make every effort to minimise the impact for residents by turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use and directing lights and noisy equipment away from properties where possible.

Equipment used may include road saw, vac truck, excavator, roller, light vehicles and lighting towers.

Traffic Changes

During the work there will be an increase in vehicle movements in and around the local streets however these will only be light vehicles and deliveries. Heavy vehicles will go directly to the work site areas only. There may be some temporary lane closures during this work. We will notify residents and road users closer to the date if these are required.

During the night work activities there will be a temporary full ramp closure on M4 Westbound off-ramp. The closure will ensure the work zone is safe for workers and road users. Traffic control will be in place. Residents and road users will be advised by VMS signage closer to the date. A detour will be required via the Mamre Road westbound exit (as per map below).
