

## Work continues on M4 Roper Road westbound on-ramp project from 19 November 2021

The NSW Government is funding this project to ease congestion on the M4 Motorway on ramps and local roads within Erskine Park and St Clair.

The first stages of work have been completed and we will now commence work along the alignment of the project which will occur over a 12 week period from **19 November 2021**, weather permitting. During this period we will:

- relocate cameras monitoring M4 traffic
- clearing vegetation and topsoil
- commence drainage work along the project alignment
- continue earthworks in proposed work areas – reshaping of the area to make room to commence construction of the new ramp and merge lane
- relocate the emergency phone.

We have included a map to show the location of the work.

## Our work schedule

We will work for around 50 day shifts between Friday 19 November to Friday 11 February 2022, weather permitting.

Work during the day will occur on weekdays between 7am to 6pm and Saturdays between 7am to 6pm in compliance with the Government's COVID Response and Recovery for construction sites and public infrastructure.

We may have to carry out some tasks at night outside of the standard construction hours. We shall notify you prior to this work commencing. These hours would be between 8pm to 5am.

## How will the work affect you?

There may be some disruption associated with this work including vehicle movements during the set up and use of this facility. Machinery and equipment used during the site construction may include trucks, rollers, concrete trucks and equipment, power generators, hand tools and light vehicles.

We will make every effort to minimise impact to the local community and motorists in the area. Access will be maintained at all times for local residents, should there be a need to limit access at any time residents will be notified in advance.

## Traffic changes

During the work there will be an increase in vehicle movements in and around the local streets however these will only be light vehicles and deliveries. Heavy vehicles will go directly to the work site areas only.

There may be some temporary lane closures during this work, we will notify residents and motorists closer to the date.
