

M4 Smart Motorway

Gantry installations at St Marys/Orchard Hills

The NSW Government is investing \$600 million to build the **M4 Smart Motorway**. The first of its kind in NSW, this system is now active and uses smart technology on the M4 Motorway between Pitt Street Mays Hill and Mulgoa Road, Penrith.

The M4 Smart Motorway will provide more reliable journeys for motorists, reduced average travel times and manage traffic flow along the whole motorway to reduce accidents by up to 30 percent.

Work has now started to install an additional eight overhead gantries along the M4 Motorway between Mamre Road at St Marys and Mulgoa Road at Penrith.

Most sections of the M4 Smart Motorway have returned to the original speed limit. Where construction continues, temporary speed limits will remain in place. Please take note of the signage and drive within the speed limit.

M4 closed 11pm to 4am

Transport for NSW will install the final four additional overhead gantries along the M4 Motorway between Mamre Road and The Northern Road during a night closure of the M4.

Our next gantry installations will require closing the M4 between **Mamre Road** and **The Northern Road** from **11pm Monday 19 April** until **4am Tuesday 20 April**.

When the project is complete, the gantries will provide motorists with information on current or alternate speed limits and lane status.



Our work schedule

We will be on site for **one night** between **8pm Monday 19 April** and **4am Tuesday 20 April**.

The M4 Motorway will be **closed for one night** between Mamre Road, St Marys and The Northern Road, Penrith from **11pm to 4am**.

Closure dates may change due to weather or other conditions.

Day work on the project will continue to take place between **7am** and **6pm** from **Monday** to **Friday** and **8am** and **1pm** **Saturday**.

Traffic changes and detours

There will be temporary traffic changes during the closures to ensure the work zone is safe. Detours will be in place and may affect travel times.

Light and heavy vehicles will be diverted onto the Great Western Highway from Mamre Road and The Northern Road.

Motorists travelling along Kent Road can enter the M4 to travel eastbound only. We have included a detour map to show the alternate route and closures.

To ensure the safety of workers and motorists, please keep to speed limits and follow detour signs and traffic controllers' directions.

How will the work affect you?

Our work may be noisy at times, but we will do everything we can to minimise noise and other facts, including:

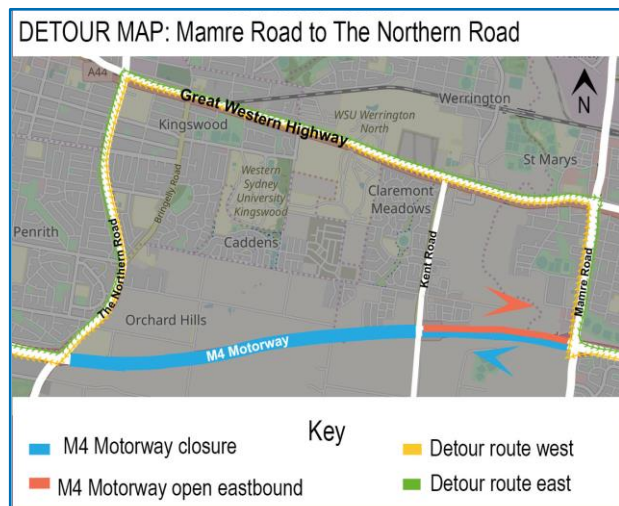
- ensuring that lighting is facing away from properties wherever possible
- briefing workers to minimise noise
- using squawkers rather than beepers on reversing vehicles.

Which ramps will be closed?

During the M4 closure between Mamre Road and The Northern Road, the following ramps will be **closed from 11pm**:

- The Northern Road eastbound on ramp
- Mamre Road westbound on ramp
- Kent Road westbound off ramp

All ramps will be reopened by **4am**.
