

## Road upgrade on Main Road, Heddon Greta restarting from Sunday 22 May

The NSW Government is funding a road upgrade from near Young Street to near Trenchard Street to improve traffic flow and safety as traffic volumes increase.

Transport for NSW is restarting work on the Main Road upgrade following some delays. From **Sunday 22 May**, we will be working at night between **7pm** and **5am** from **Sunday** to **Thursday** for **two weeks**, weather permitting. Work will involve:

- Shoulder widening work on the westbound road shoulder near Averys Lane
- Permanently closing the entry to and exit from Averys Lane on Main Road

From **Sunday 29 May**, we will implement the traffic switch which involves installing new line marking and shifting concrete barriers. The traffic switch will require some changes:

- On street parking will be removed on the northern side of Main Road from about 100 metres west of Stanford Street to Heddon Street
- Entry to and exit from Stanford Street on the northern side of Main Road will be temporarily closed
- Stanford Street on southern side of Main Road will become left in/left out
- Heddon Street will be opened to all turning movements (traffic lights will not be operational)
- Access to properties on the northern side of Main Road will be managed through the work zone

This work will enable us to shift traffic to the southern side of the road (closer to the shops) to allow watermain relocation work to start on the opposite side of the road.

From **Monday 6 June**, we will be working during the day between **7am** and **5pm** from **Monday** to **Friday**. On occasion the work will require some night shifts and temporary watermain shutdowns, however we will notify the community before this takes place.

The contractor delivering the watermain work will be onsite carrying out preparation and establishment work for one week, with the main watermain construction starting from **Tuesday 14 June**.

The watermain construction will be delivered in sections and will gradually move throughout the site. Our road crews will be following behind to start the road work in these sections, including installing kerb and gutter, drainage and building the new road surface. The project is expected to be completed in **early 2023**.

### How will the work affect you?

The work will involve the use of machinery which generates some noise. We will make every effort to minimise noise by arranging the work in stages at different locations, completing noisier activities during the day or earlier in the night and turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use.

During this next stage of work, access to properties on the northern side of Main Road between Stanford Street and Heddon Street will be managed through the work zone. We will doorknock these properties to speak with residents about these changes and how to safely access your property.

## Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe. A 40km/h speed limit will be in place during work hours and may affect travel times.

As outlined over the page, there will be access changes for Stanford Street during this stage of work. Heddon Street will be reopened under traffic control to replace the movements we have to restrict at Stanford Street. On street parking will be removed on the northern side of Main Road from about 100 metres west of Stanford Street to Heddon Street.

Further traffic switches will be implemented at later stages of the project.
