

New and extended clearways on Marsden Road from Dundas Valley to Carlingford

The NSW Government is funding this project as part of its \$121 million Clearways Program, which aims to reduce congestion and delays on Sydney's roads.

Roads and Maritime Services invited feedback in August and September on a proposal to install new and extended clearways on Marsden Road from Stewart Street, Dundas Valley to Pennant Hills Road, Carlingford. We have included a map to show the proposal.

We received submissions from 19 people. Seven submissions supported the proposal with no issues raised or modifications suggested. 12 submissions provided suggestions or raised concerns relating to the proposal and on a broad range of topics. We have summarised the feedback and our responses to the proposal are in a Community Consultation Report, which is available on our website, at rms.nsw.gov.au/clearways. We thank everyone for considering the proposal and for their feedback.

After considering all the technical information and community comments, along with the proposal's aims and design requirements, we have decided to proceed with the proposal unchanged. The new and extended clearways will operate in both directions from:

- **6am to 7pm weekdays**
- **9am to 6pm weekends and public holidays.**

The existing parking restrictions would continue to operate unchanged outside of the proposed clearway hours. Changes to the clearways will be operational from **Monday 20 November**. Any vehicles parked in the clearways on or after this date would risk being fined and towed.

What happens next?

We will be on site to implement the clearways between **Monday 6 November** and **Sunday 19 November**, excluding public holidays and weather permitting. Our working hours will be between **8pm** and **5am** from **Monday to Sunday**. There will be minimal noise associated with this work, and we will do everything we can to minimise its impact.

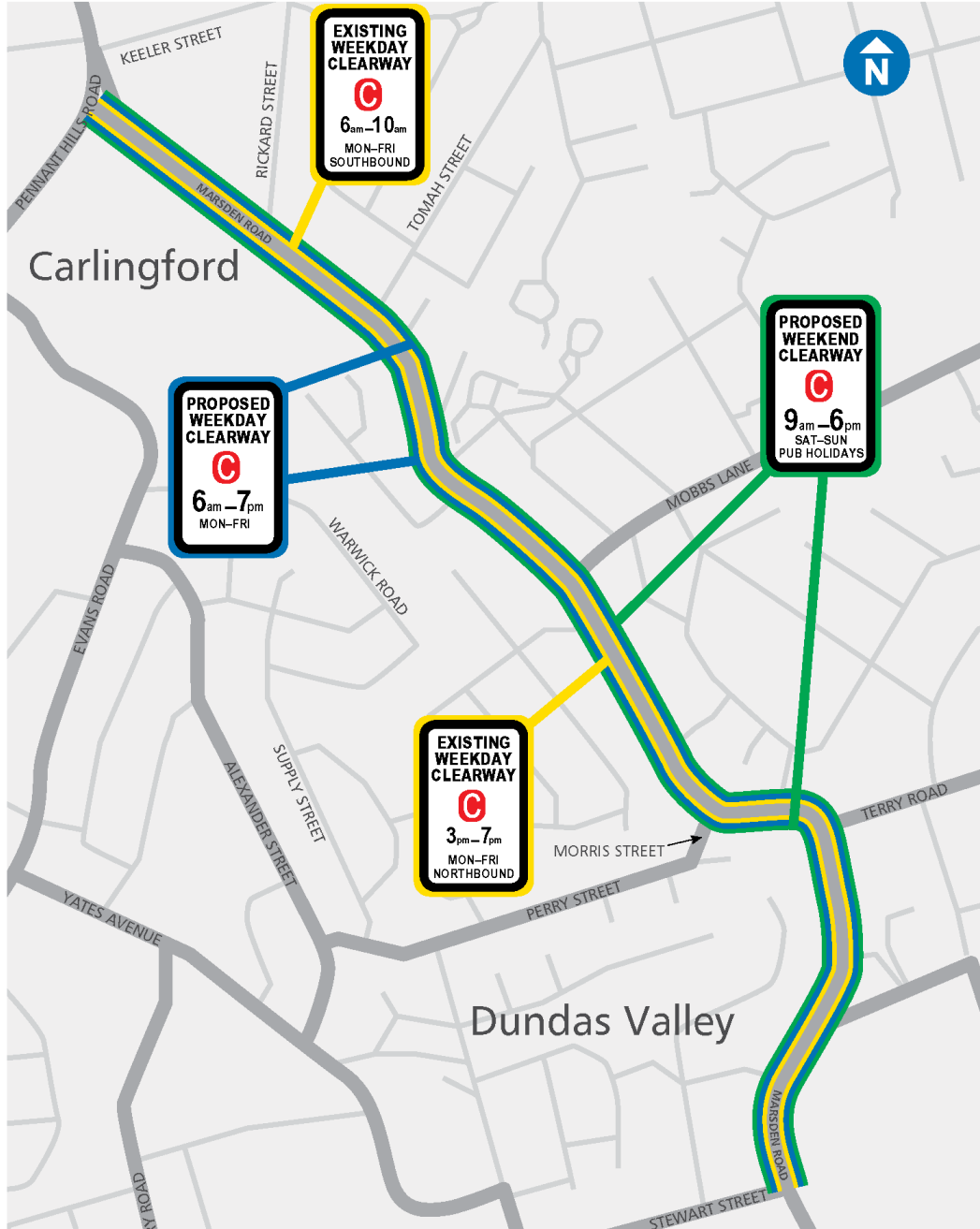
Traffic changes
