McMahons Point Wharf and interchange upgrade

Early morning and night work

The NSW Government is upgrading McMahon's Point Wharf as part of the Transport Access Program.

Work is progressing well and we thank you for your patience during the early morning and night work to install piles and sections of the wharf. It is expected the noisy work to install piles will be complete by the end of June 2016, weather permitting.

Further work will be required on some nights, to lift sections of the wharf in place, weather permitting. We will work up to **10 shifts** between **Sunday 3 July and Friday 15 July**. Our working hours are **11pm to 7am, Sunday to Thursday**.

This work requires very still water for safety and accuracy. These conditions usually occur at night and in the early hours of the morning when wind is low and there are fewer boats in the harbour. Work is not expected to be noisy.
