Changes to bus stops on Gibson Avenue and Ryan Road, Padstow

Community update | June 2020



The NSW Government has funded the Gateway to the South bus improvements program, which aims to improve bus reliability on southern Sydney's main bus corridors.

Community consultation

Transport for NSW would like to thank everyone for the feedback they provided on the proposed bus stop changes that were presented to the community from 21 November 2019 to 13 December 2019.

The proposed changes are aimed at improving bus reliability and on-time running along the Miranda to Bankstown via Menai and Padstow bus corridor.

The proposal prioritises:

- Reducing congestion and improving safety for all road users along the corridor.
- Improving traffic movement and efficiency along the bus corridor to reduce journey times for bus customers and motorists.
- Upgrading bus stop infrastructure (where bus stop changes are proposed) to comply with the necessary accessibility requirements.

A key customer outcome is safety and performance, which seeks to ensure that every customer enjoys safe travel across a high performing network. It also reflects what our customers tell us about bus services, with travel time and on-time running being some of the most important service features.

Consultation findings

During the consultation period, we received your feedback regarding the proposed bus stop changes along suburban bus route 13 via 50 emails, 15 phone calls and 70 door knocks.

Key comments received were around:

- Reason for the project
- Support for the project
- Limited parking
- Property impacts

Changes to the proposal

After considering all feedback, we have decided to proceed with some changes to the original proposal as summarised in the table below:

Gibson Avenue


Bus stop location	Original proposal	Amendments	Associated bus stop upgrades
Gibson Avenue before Gow Street	Remove southbound bus stop ID 221144 before Gow Street. Replace this with 'No Stopping'.	No change.	The adjoining bus stops comply with accessibility requirements.
Gibson Avenue before Stiles Avenue	Remove northbound bus stop ID 221188 before Stiles Avenue. Replace this with two unrestricted parking spaces.	No change.	The adjoining bus stops comply with accessibility requirements.



Ryan Road

Bus stop location	Original proposal	Amendments	Associated bus stop upgrades
Ryan Road between Davies Road and Parker Lane	Remove westbound bus stops: ID 221113 and 221111. Replace this with 'No Stopping.'	Replace 'No Stopping' with 4 one-hour parking spaces.	The adjoining bus stops comply with accessibility requirements.
	Relocate westbound bus stop ID 221112 by 50 metres east to allow buses to safely enter and exit the bus stop. Replace this with parking. This will result in the removal of up to four unrestricted parking spaces at the new location.	Relocate bus stop 50 metres west (instead of east), as discussed with the council and community.	Upgrade this bus stop to comply with accessibility requirements.
	Extend eastbound bus stop ID 221117 by 15 metres east to allow buses to safely enter and exit the bus stop. This will result in the removal of two unrestricted parking spaces.	No change.	Upgrade this bus stop to comply with accessibility requirements.

Ryan Road between Davies Road and Parker Lane. There are some amendments to this proposal. Remove two bus stops (ID 221113 and 221111), relocate one bus stop (ID 221112) and extend one bus stop (ID 221117)



Implementation

The implementation of the bus stop changes will take place around mid-2020.

Efforts will be made to minimise any disruption to nearby residents and businesses, bus customers and road users. All bus stop work will be carried out during the day.
