

Night works at the Mitchell Highway (Cobra Street) and Fitzroy Street intersection in Dubbo from Sunday 21 November

Transport for NSW is continuing to deliver this important project. As part of this next stage of works, we will construct new pavement along all four legs of the intersection. This will allow the new permanent traffic lights at the intersection to be switched on before the end of the year.

In preparation for the traffic light switch we will need to carry out seven night shifts between **Friday 19 November** and **Saturday 27 November**, weather permitting. We will let you know in advance if we need to do any work outside these times.

Please note that during the **seven night shifts**, emergency services will have access through the intersection. We will provide further updates and information about these impacts to directly impacted residents and businesses before the work commences.

How will the work affect you?

The work will involve the use of machinery which generates some noise. We will make every effort to minimise noise by arranging the work in stages at different locations, completing noisier activities earlier in the night and turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use.

Upcoming out of hours work

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe.

- **7pm Friday 19 November to 7am Saturday 20 November** – Preparation work
- **7pm Sunday 21 November to 7am Monday 22 November** – **Cobra Street** (West bound)
- **7pm Monday 22 November to 7am Tuesday 23 November** – **Cobra Street** (East bound) and **Fitzroy Street** (southern leg)
- **7pm Tuesday 23 November to 7am Wednesday 24 November** – **Cobra Street** (shoulder and turning lanes) and **Fitzroy Street** (southern leg, left turning lane)
- **7pm Wednesday 24 November to 7am Thursday 25 November** – **Fitzroy Street** (Northern leg, south bound)
- **7pm Thursday 25 November to 7am Friday 26 November** – **Fitzroy Street** (Northern leg, north bound)
- **7pm Friday 26 November to 7am Saturday 27 November** – **Cobra Street and Fitzroy Street**

Lane closures and a 40km/h speed limit will be in place during the night work and may affect travel times. Motorists should allow up to five minutes travel time during this work.

Detour arrangements

The following detour arrangements will be in place for the duration of the works:

Eastbound and Westbound Cobra Street motorists will be required to detour via Bultje Street through Gipps Street, and Rawson Street.

Northbound and Southbound Fitzroy Street motorists will need to detour to Gipps Street via Quinn Street or Bultje Street.

Covid-19

Work crews will be adhering to strict Covid-19 protocols with approved Covid-19 safety plans in place and NSW Health work permits. The program of work is subject to change in response to any further government restrictions that may be put in place to manage Covid-19.

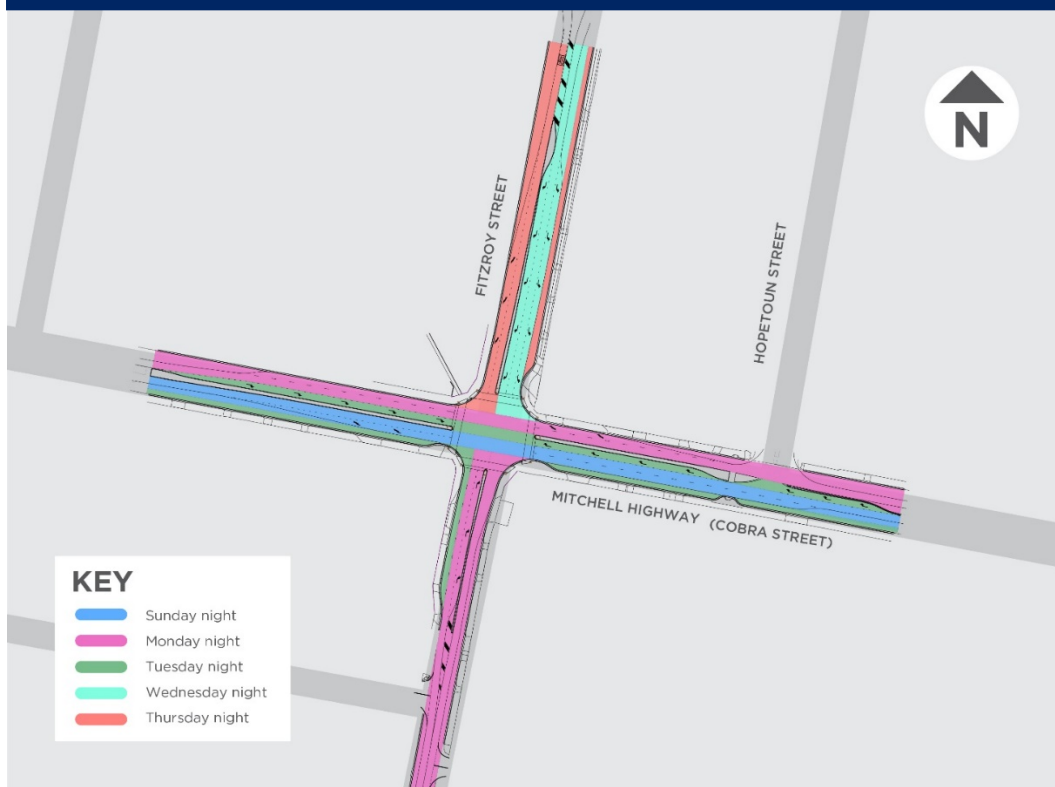
