

Traffic switch at the Mitchell Highway (Cobra St) and Fitzroy St intersection, Dubbo, from Sunday 10 October

The NSW Government is funding this \$14 million project at the intersection of Mitchell Highway (Cobra Street) and Fitzroy Street to improve safety and efficiency

Transport for NSW is continuing to deliver this important project. As part of this work, we will construct the second stage of the new pavement. We have included a map to explain the changed traffic arrangements.

To minimise impact on motorists, preparation work for this next stage will take place at night between **6pm** and **7am** on **Sunday 10 October**, weather permitting. We will let you know in advance if we need to do any work outside these times. Traffic will be moved onto the new travel lanes from **7am Monday 11 October**, weather permitting.

We will be working between **7am** and **6pm** from **Monday** to **Saturday** and expect to complete the work in **three weeks** weather permitting.

We will provide further updates and information about these impacts to directly impacted residents and businesses before the work commences.

How will the work affect you?

The work will involve the use of machinery which generates some noise. We will make every effort to minimise noise by arranging the work in stages at different locations, completing noisier activities earlier in the night and turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use.

Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe. Road barriers will be in place to separate workers and motorists. During this time, no right hand turns will be allowed for westbound and eastbound Mitchell Highway (Cobra Street) motorists. Restrictions will apply to northbound motorists on Fitzroy Street between Quinn Street and Cobra Street.

Access to Fitzroy Street between Quinn Street and Cobra Street will be restricted to Inland Petroleum and Shell service station customers and staff and local resident access only. Northbound motorists will have access to Cobra Street via Bishop Street and Quinn Street via Gipps Street.

Shell service station and Cascades customers and staff and residents along Cobra Street will have access via designated gateways. United Service Station will be accessed via Fitzroy Street and Western Cobra Street driveway.

Eastbound travel on Quinn Street between Gipps Street and Fitzroy Street will be restricted to local residents only.

All vehicles will be required to use the detour routes in place while the southern leg of the Mitchell Highway is closed. This will include local residents, emergency services and buses.

Lane closures and a 40km/h speed limit will be in place during work hours and may affect travel times. Motorists should allow up to five minutes extra travel time during this work.
