

Reduced speed on the Mitchell Highway near Thompson Road in Orange from Monday 12 July

Following the recent crash near the southern end of Thompson Road, the speed limit will be reduced on a section of the Mitchell Highway from 100km/hr to 80km/hr, extending from approximately 400 metres from either side of the intersection. Further safety improvements at this intersection are being finalised for delivery this financial year. The map below shows the location of the reduced speed limit.

The new speed limit of 80km/hr will come into effect from **Monday, 12 July**. This will be in place until further notice from Transport for NSW.
