## Mogo pedestrian safety improvements

### **Mogo pedestrian safety improvements – November 2021**

Transport for NSW is developing options to improve pedestrian safety along the Princes Highway at Mogo. These options have been developed based on feedback from the community in late 2020.

We are inviting the community to provide feedback on the proposed options to make Mogo a safer, better connected and more appealing place.

Following feedback we will carry out further investigation and design work to refine the designs. We will keep the community updated as the project progresses.

**Feedback is open until 22 December 2021.**

#### **What are the plans for pedestrian safety improvements in Mogo?**

We are looking at ways to make Mogo a safer and more accessible place for pedestrians. Improved pedestrian safety and access will support the growth of local businesses and the economy in the area. Improvements will help support tourism and allow residents and visitors to easily access the town centre.



**Are the proposed pedestrian safety improvements confirmed?**

The options are based on feedback from the community and Eurobodalla Shire Council .

Following feedback we will carry out further investigation and design work to refine the designs. We will keep the community updated as the project progresses.

**What feedback has been carried out so far?**

In November 2020, we received feedback from more than 240 members of the community. Key themes raised included pedestrian safety and accessibility, parking and making it more appealing for road users and pedestrians to stop and explore the village.

Recommendations included:

- traffic lights at local intersections
- a pedestrian crossing
- investigation of alternative parking locations off the highway
- improved signage and access to the Church Street carpark
- improved signage and improved pedestrian and shared paths.

### **How does this connect with Eurobodalla Shire Council's plans for Mogo, including the draft Mogo Activation Plan?**

Eurobodalla Shire Council's Mogo Activation Plan is focused on improving pedestrian safety in Mogo Village. Transport and Council continue to work closely to ensure the plans for Mogo are aligned. The Princes Highway is Transport's asset, so our focus is pedestrian connectivity and traffic management on the highway corridor through Mogo.

### **How would the pedestrian safety improvements in Mogo align with the longer-term plans of the Princes Highway upgrade program?**

Pedestrian safety improvements at Mogo are part of the short-term priorities in the 20-year plan for the Princes Highway upgrade program. Priorities of the 20-year plan include:

- Short term infrastructure priority - planning safety works from Batemans Bay to Moruya
- Short term service priority - improved public and active (walking and cycling) transport.

### **Has a Mogo bypass been considered?**

A bypass of Mogo is outside the scope of this consultation. This consultation is focused on getting feedback from the community to improve pedestrian safety and accessibility in Mogo. This aligns with the 20-year plan for the Princes Highway upgrade.

The development and delivery of improved pedestrian facilities in Mogo does not preclude the future planning of a bypass should it be required in the future.
