Work at Mona Vale Road between the Mona Vale Cemetery and Foley Street from 2 September


The NSW Government is investing \$140 million to upgrade Mona Vale Road between Manor Road, Ingleside, and Foley Street, Mona Vale, from two to four lanes to improve safety and traffic efficiency

Roads and Maritime Services is upgrading Mona Vale Road between Ingleside and Mona Vale from two to four lanes. As part of this work we have been carrying out activities on the western end of the project between Manor Road and the Mona Vale Cemetery.

From **Monday 2 September** to **Tuesday 31 December 2019** we will start working on the eastern end of the project between Mona Vale Cemetery and Foley Street. During this time our work will include:

- utility survey and investigation using a small vaccuum truck
- vegetation clearing
- relocating fencing along some property boundaries
- removing parking along Mona Vale Road
- temporarily moving the bus stop near Foley Street to the east for the 196 and 197 bus services.

How will the work affect you?

The clearing work along Mona Vale Road between the Mona Vale Cemetery and Foley Street, Mona Vale will involve machinery that will create dust and noise. Some of this work needs to take place at night.

There is noise, vibration and dust associated with our work. We make every effort to minimise the impact by notifying residents directly before work starts near their property.

Our standard working hours are between 7am and 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm on Saturdays. Out of hours work may occur on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday or Friday nights from 8pm to 5am with up to three shifts per week, weather permitting

During night work we direct light away from residential properties, use noise shields where possible, and turn off equipment and vehicles when not in use. To minimise the impact of night work on residents, we will not work for more than two consecutive nights in the same area. We will advise residents before starting night work near properties.

Traffic changes

We will make new line markings as the current road lanes will be shifted towards the north and temporary concrete barriers placed along the southern side of the road to separate the construction zones from the general public.

We will maintain pedestrian access during the upgrade work. Please follow signs and traffic controllers' directions.

Any out of hours lane closure will allow one direction of traffic to flow through at a time through a stop/slow arrangement.
