Moruya bypass - Landowners August 2021

Transport for NSW has developed a strategic roadmap for the Princes Highway to deliver a vision for the Princes Highway as a safe, reliable, efficient and connected network. This includes plans for a proposed Moruya bypass.

When will I know if my property will be acquired?

At this early stage, we have identified a preferred strategic corridor. Transport is consulting closely with landowners near the preferred strategic corridor to find ways to minimise impacts on properties as part of the design. More investigation work is required on this corridor before we finalise the preferred option.

More information on what properties would require acquisition will be confirmed once the preferred option has been finalised.

Will there be property acquisitions and will I be affected?

Some properties and businesses will be impacted by the project. We will be in contact with property owners and tenants who may be directly affected and provide the necessary support throughout the project.
