

Frequently Asked Questions

Q. What is a Flood Focus Group?

A. The Flood Focus Group for the Moruya bypass will provide an opportunity for participants to share local and expert knowledge about flooding in the area. The input received from the Group about flooding behaviour will be reported on as part of the current feedback Transport is receiving on the project.

Q. Can the flood focus group make changes to the route of the bypass?

A. Transport is currently seeking feedback on the three shortlisted corridors – Purple, Orange and Yellow. The flood focus group can raise issues to be considered to help improve the design specifically in relation to flooding.

Q. I'm interested in what happens to Moruya but I'm not sure I know enough about flooding to be much help.

A. Part of the flood focus group involves participants gaining a better understanding of how flooding in the area works and how it is being considered when designing the bypass. We are interested in having participants that represent a cross-section of the community involved in these important decisions.

Q. How often is the flood focus group going to meet and where will the meetings be held?

A. Four meetings will be held in the evening during May and June 2022 as follows:

- Monday 16 May at the Moruya Showground
- Monday 30 May at the Moruya Golf Club
- Wednesday 15 June at the Moruya Golf Club
- Wednesday 29 June at the Moruya Golf Club

Transport will provide a light meal at 5pm for a start at 5:30pm. The meetings will conclude at 8pm

Q. I only have a general question about flooding and don't feel I need to attend a flood focus group. Is there another way I can get an answer to my flood question?

A. A general flood information sessions is being hosted by Transport on Tuesday 31 May 2020. We currently have three bookable sessions between 12pm – 1pm, 3pm – 4pm and 6pm – 7pm. Q. I am interested in the flood focus group but I am retired and am no longer involved in any community groups. Does this exclude me from applying?

A. You should still apply. We are looking for members from all age groups. Tell us about the community groups you used to be involved with.

Q. If I am selected for the flood focus group, is there much work to review before each meeting?

A. There is no preparation required before each meeting.
