

Work progressing on Mulgoa Road and Castlereagh Road, Penrith from 25 February

The Australian and NSW governments are jointly funding the \$105 million upgrade of Mulgoa Road, Penrith from Union Road to Museum Drive.



Roads and Maritime Services has started work on this project which includes replacing the existing railway bridge with a wider bridge to help improve traffic flow at this pinch point along the Mulgoa Road/Castlereagh Road corridor.

From **Monday 25 February 2019** we will be carrying out vegetation removal and other activities along Mulgoa Road and Castlereagh Road to make room for an additional lane in each direction. Traffic management will be in place along Mulgoa and Castlereagh roads for pedestrian safety.





Our work schedule

Work will be carried out between Monday 25 February and Saturday 6 April 2019, weather permitting.

Day and night work will take place between **7am** and **6pm**, and night work between **9pm** and **6am** Monday to Friday, and Saturdays **8am** to **1pm**.

The work will include the following activities:

- delivery of plant, equipment and materials
- modifying the median strip on Mulgoa Road and Castlereagh Road
- road surfacing work, temporary line marking, excavation, earthwork and concreting
- utility investigation and relocation
- vegetation removal in the project area
- potholing and piling for bridge structures
- trenching and drainage work
- installing pedestrian fencing and detours, traffic barriers and signs on Castlereagh Road, Mulgoa Road, Union Road and High Street.

How will the work affect you?

Temporary closures to footpaths will be in place on the corner of High Street and Castlereagh Road, and Castlereagh Road outside Lion Dairy. Detours will be put in place to provide safe pedestrian access around work sites.

Our work may be noisy at times but we will do everything we can to minimise its impact, including completing the noisier tasks by **10pm**.

Traffic changes

There will be temporary traffic changes during our work hours to ensure the work zone is safe. At times partial lane closures will be in place that may affect travel times. Please keep to speed limits and follow detour signs and traffic controllers' directions.
