# Field investigations and night work on Mulgoa Road and Castlereagh Road, Penrith, between Jane Street and High Street, from Monday 1 May 2017

The Australian and NSW governments are jointly funding the \$70 million Jane Street and Mulgoa Road Infrastructure Upgrade. The vital upgrade will connect road users to the Penrith CBD and ease congestion at these intersections.

Roads and Maritime Services will be carrying out field investigations to locate utilities as part of work to further refine the design of the Jane Street and Mulgoa Road Infrastructure Upgrade.

These investigations include minor excavation and will take place at multiple locations within the designated project boundary. We have included a map to show where we will be working.

The work will take up to 25 shifts to complete between 7am and 6pm from **Monday 1 May to Monday 5 June 2017**, weather permitting. In order to minimise impact on motorists, some night work will be carried out between **8pm and 5am** when traffic volumes are lower.

### How will the work affect you?

Our work may be noisy however we will make every effort to minimise noise by arranging the work in stages at different locations and scheduling work near residential areas earlier in the evening.

#### **Traffic changes**

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure that work zones are safe. Lane closures will be in place and may affect travel times however access to properties and businesses will be maintained.
