# Start of work on Mulgoa Road, from Union Road to Museum Drive, Penrith from 5 December 2018

Work will take place on Mulgoa and Castlereagh roads between **7am** and **6pm** on weekdays from **Wednesday 5 December 2018**, and **Saturday** between **8am** and **1pm**, weather permitting (except from **22 December 2018** to **6 January 2019** when there will be no work).

#### Our work will include:

- Utilities exploration in the vicinity of Castlereagh Road
- Establishment of a site office at the Carpenter site facility
- Storage area for project materials next to the Nepean District Tennis Association tennis courts which is currently the location of the Penrith Community temporary car park.

A temporary car park (marked brown in the map) will be built just to the west of the current Council car park (marked yellow in the map) at the Woodriff Gardens site. This will ensure no net loss in parking. Associated drainage will also be installed under the new temporary Council car park and an access track to and from the car park.

The new temporary Council car park is expected to be operational from **Saturday 19 January 2019.** Access to the new temporary carpark will remain from the existing access off Castlereagh Road with any changes being clearly sign posted.

## How will the work affect you?

Earthwork, constructing drainage and road building, asphalting, relocating lighting, installing and adjusting temporary barriers, signage and line marking will be carried out.

The work may be noisy at times and will involve heavy vehicle movements, excavators, a vibration sheet pile hammer for fencing and barriers, noise from cranes, the cutting of materials with hand tools, and the loading and unloading of vehicles.

Every effort will be made to minimise impact on residents, businesses, and users of the current carpark by:

- · Adapting our construction methods to reduce noise and dust
- Using equipment fitted with noise mitigation devices
- · Periodic monitoring of noise and dust
- Keeping in regular contact with key stakeholders during the work
- Provision of clear signposting to assist users of the Council car parking at the Woodriff Gardens site.

## Traffic changes

Some variable speed zones will be in effect on Mulgoa and Castlereagh roads during work hours.

Site set-up and carpark work will take place under traffic control. For your safety, please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of detour signs and traffic controllers.
