JANE STREET AND MULGOA ROAD INFRASTRUCTURE UPGRADE

Preferred option for Jane Street and Mulgoa Road Infrastructure Upgrade

The Australian and NSW governments have committed \$35 million each toward developing and constructing road improvements to alleviate congestion and improve traffic flow along Mulgoa Road and Castlereagh Road adjacent to Penrith's CBD.

Following consultation between December 2014 and February 2015 Roads and Maritime Services has published a report summarising community feedback for the Jane Street and Mulgoa Road Infrastructure upgrade project to help alleviate congestion and improve traffic flow near the Nepean River and Penrith's CBD.

Roads and Maritime displayed the Preferred Option Report identifying Option 12 as the preferred option. This consultation was carried out between December 2014 and February 2015. Roads and Maritime would like to thank everyone who took the time to review the preferred option report and provide feedback.

Community feedback

Roads and Maritime received 23 submissions raising 48 separate matters from members of the community who identified as local residents, commuters or organisations, including Penrith City Council.

The main points raised related to the design of the preferred option, project scope, flooding and traffic.

Other feedback received included general accessibility, construction, environment, heritage, safety and local traffic movements.

Roads and Maritime has prepared a community consultation report which provides a summary of comments and responses. The report is available to view on Roads and Maritime's website at www.rms.nsw.gov.au/projects/sydneywest and search for Jane Street and Mulgoa Road Infrastructure Upgrade.

Next steps

The feedback and comments received will help with developing and preparing the concept design and environmental impact assessment.

The next stage of consultation will be the exhibition of the concept design and the Review of Environmental Factors. This is expected to be carried out early next year.
