Traffic changes on Castlereagh Road and Jane Street, Penrith from Friday 1 January 2021

The Australian and NSW governments are jointly funding the upgrade of Mulgoa Road, Penrith from Union Road to Museum Drive.

Transport for NSW has progressed significant work on this upgrade including a major traffic switch in October 2020. Transport thanks the community and local businesses for their patience during this important work.


The upgrade has taken longer to complete than originally planned due to additional work required to adjust existing public utility assets. As a result of this work, we expect to complete the upgrade in mid-2021. Over the coming months we will carry out important work including drainage upgrades in Jane Street, High Street, Castlereagh Road and Mulgoa Road.

Castlereagh Road closure

To enable us to progress key work, and to take advantage of lower traffic volumes early in the New Year holiday period, Castlereagh Road between Thornton Drive and Jane Street will be closed from **5am Friday 1 January** to **5am Saturday 9 January 2021**

A detour will be in place via Andrews Road, Parker Street and Jane Street.

Southbound access to Museum Drive will remain open for local traffic at all times during the closure.









Road users are expected to experience delays on the detour route during the closure. Motorists are encouraged to plan ahead, allow extra travel time of 15 minutes for the detour route outside of peak travel times and use alternative routes or avoid the area where possible.

Jane Street contraflow

To continue building the road surface at the Jane Street and Castlereagh Street intersection, Jane Street will operate at reduced capacity in two stages:

- Stage 1 7am Friday 1 January to 5am Tuesday 5 January 2021
- Stage 2 5am Tuesday 5 January to 5am Saturday 9 January 2021





High Street closure

For further road construction, High Street between Mulgoa Road and Council access road will be closed for a full weekend from **7pm Friday 15 January** to **5am Monday 18 January 2021**, weather permitting.

A detour will be in place via Henry Street, Station Street and Jane Street.

Road users are expected to experience delays. Plan ahead, allow extra travel time and use alternative routes where possible. To access the Penrith CBD, motorists are encouraged to use Jane Street.







High Street bus stop closure

Bus stop ID 2750398, located on High Street at Castlereagh Road, will be temporarily closed from **7pm Friday 15 January** to **5am Monday 18 January 2021**. For bus services 688, 689, 690P and 691, please use bus stop ID 275079 located at Penrith Station Stand E.

Traffic changes

During lane closures there will be traffic control and a reduced speed limit of 40 km/hr for the safety of workers, motorists, cyclists and pedestrians. For your safety please follow traffic signs.

Please follow direction of traffic controllers, speed and detour signs. All traffic changes will be temporary during our standard work hours. For the latest traffic updates call 132 701, or visit livetraffic.com.au

Work in progress

The following work activities will be carried out between **Tuesday 5 January** and **Sunday 28 February 2021**, weather permitting. Our work hours are Monday to Friday between **7am** and **6pm**, Saturdays **7am** to **5pm** and **5pm** and **5am**.

- Constructing new road pavement
- Deliveries of equipment and materials
- Directional signage installation
- Line marking
- Intelligent Transport System (ITS) installation
- Footpath work and landscaping.

We will keep you further informed of upcoming road closures.

How will the work affect you?

- There will be temporary traffic lane closures on Mulgoa Road, Castlereagh Road, High Street and Jane Street from **Monday** to **Sunday** between **7pm** and **5am**.
- Pedestrian and cyclist detours will be in place on Mulgoa Road, Castlereagh Road, High Street and Jane Street for their safety.

At times our work may be noisy. We will minimise impacts by aiming to complete noisier tasks by **11pm** and staging work in different locations.
