

Investigation work on Mulgoa Road, between Glenmore Parkway to Jeanette Street and Blaikie Road to Union Road in September and October

The NSW Government is planning to widen and upgrade Mulgoa Road to support current and future traffic demands and expected growth in the area.

Transport for NSW has upcoming investigatory fieldwork planned along the Mulgoa Road corridor. This work will involve the completion of an arborist survey over four days to investigate the potential impacts and consider future management of established trees.

An arborist and surveyor will be around the future project site to conduct the study which includes identifying tree species and recording tree locations and dimensions. The proposed days of the site investigation are:

- Thursday 16 and Friday 17 September
- Thursday 21 and Friday 22 October.

These dates could be subject to change, weather permitting. The information collected will be a key input into the Request for Environmental Factors of the project.



How will the work affect you?

This work is investigatory and will not directly impact the local community. All fieldwork is planned on public land and access to private property will not be required.

Transport has assessed the risks associated with this fieldwork in relation to COVID-19. Work will take place exclusively outdoors, at a distance from other people. A COVID Safety Plan will be in place during the work.
