Traffic changes on Castlereagh Road and Mulgoa Road, Penrith from Friday 8 May 2020

The Australian and NSW governments are jointly funding the upgrade of Mulgoa Road, Penrith from Union Road to Museum Drive.

Transport for NSW is continuing work on this project to improve the traffic flow along the Mulgoa Road and Castlereagh Road corridor, including the High Street and Jane Street intersections. With less people driving on the roads during this unprecedented time, we will implement some traffic changes over the coming weeks, to take advantage of the lower traffic volumes, and carry out important work on the project.







Castlereagh Road lane closures

For excavation and stormwater drainage installation work, we will temporarily close the northbound lanes on Castlereagh Road between Jane Street and Museum Drive for two consecutive weekends. Access on Castlereagh Road will be maintained with one lane open in each direction on the southbound side.

- Closed from 7pm Friday 8 May and opening to traffic at 5am Monday 11 May 2020
- Closed from 7pm Friday 15 May and opening to traffic at 5am Monday 18 May 2020

We will also carry out rail work during the shutdown of the Blue Mountains Line from **2am Saturday 16 May** to **2am Monday 18 May**. Please call 131500 or check *Upcoming Trackwork* on the Transportnsw.info website to find out about changes to train timetables and alternative buses.

Mulgoa Road lane closures

From **5am Monday 18 May** for around six weeks, the right turn lane from Mulgoa Road into Union Road will be closed to install new road surface in this area, weather permitting. A detour via **High Street** and **Worth Street** will be in place.

Traffic changes

Temporary traffic changes will be in place to ensure the work zone is safe for workers and road users. Electronic message signs will also be in place to direct road users through these changes.

Pedestrian and cyclist detours continue to be in place on Mulgoa Road, Castlereagh Road, High Street and Jane Street for their safety.

How will the work affect you?

During our work, we will make every effort to minimise the impact on residents and businesses by:

- using non-tonal reversing beepers on machinery
- turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use
- using lighting towers only when necessary
- directing noise generating equipment away from resident properties where possible
- completing noisier work by 11pm.

The project team will use a variety of machinery to excavate the existing road and install drainage, including excavators, bogie trucks, road saws, heavy and light vehicles, compactors, lighting towers, and power and hand tools.
