Start of work for new car park from Monday 6 June for Mulgoa Road, Penrith upgrade

Transport for NSW | May 2022

The Australian and NSW governments jointly funded the Mulgoa Road, Penrith - from Union Road to Museum Drive including Railway Bridge upgrade. This vital upgrade is now open to traffic and connects road users to the Penrith CBD and eases congestion at these intersections.

What we are doing

To increase parking capacity in the Penrith city area, Transport for NSW will be building a new public car park between the Nepean District Tennis Association tennis court and the rail line. This car park will have capacity for 126 cars.

Our work will include earthwork, stormwater drainage, kerb and gutter, pavement work, signposting, line marking, footpaths, lighting, CCTV installation and landscaping. The project will also include some minor safety work.

A site compound will be established behind the Nepean District tennis courts in the carpark off Castlereagh Road. This site compound will be used to provide site offices, amenities for staff, storage, deliveries, and car parking. There will be reduced parking limits in the current car park during construction.



How will the work affect you?

The work will involve the use of machinery inclusive of an excavator, dozer, trucks and bogies, rollers, grader, delivery trucks, powered hand tools, asphalt paving machinery and chippers, which will generate some noise during the work. However, we will minimise noise where possible and ensure equipment and vehicles are turned off when not in use. We will have to carry out some work at night, but we will finish high noise works by **midnight** whenever possible.

Our work schedule

Work is scheduled to commence from **Monday 6 June 2022** with expected completion by **November 2022**. Our standard work hours will be **Monday to Friday from 7am to 6pm, and Saturdays between 8am and 1pm**. We will not work on Public Holidays. When night works are necessary, these will take place on **Sunday to Friday nights from 8pm to 5am**.

Traffic changes

While we will try minimising disruption to traffic, temporary traffic changes will be required at times to ensure the work zone is safe. Partial lane closures and a reduced 40km/h speed limit will be place. There may be some low impact work during the day where traffic closures are not required.
