Traffic changes on High Street, Castlereagh Road and Mulgoa Road, Penrith from Friday 26 February 2021

The Australian and NSW governments are jointly funding the upgrade of Mulgoa Road, Penrith from Union Road to Museum Drive.

Work is continuing on this project to improve the traffic flow along the Mulgoa Road and Castlereagh Road corridor, including the High Street and Jane Street intersections.



Traffic switch on Castlereagh Road and Mulgoa Road

From **9am Sunday 28 February 2021**, Castlereagh Road and Mulgoa Road southbound lanes will be shifted east to create worksites in the centre of Castlereagh Road and Mulgoa Road to build medians.

Pedestrian access on the western side of Castlereagh Road between Museum Drive and Jane Street will be closed. The newly constructed footpath on the eastern side of Castlereagh Road will be open to pedestrians. The pedestrian crossing at the Jane Street and Castlereagh Road intersection will reopen.

Castlereagh Road closure

To facilitate barrier relocation and line marking, Castlereagh Road between Jane Street and Thornton Drive will be closed from:

- **7pm Saturday 27 February to 9am Sunday 28 February 2021**, weather permitting

A detour will be in place via Andrews Road, Parker Street and Jane Street.

Southbound access to Museum Drive will remain open for local traffic at all times during the closure.

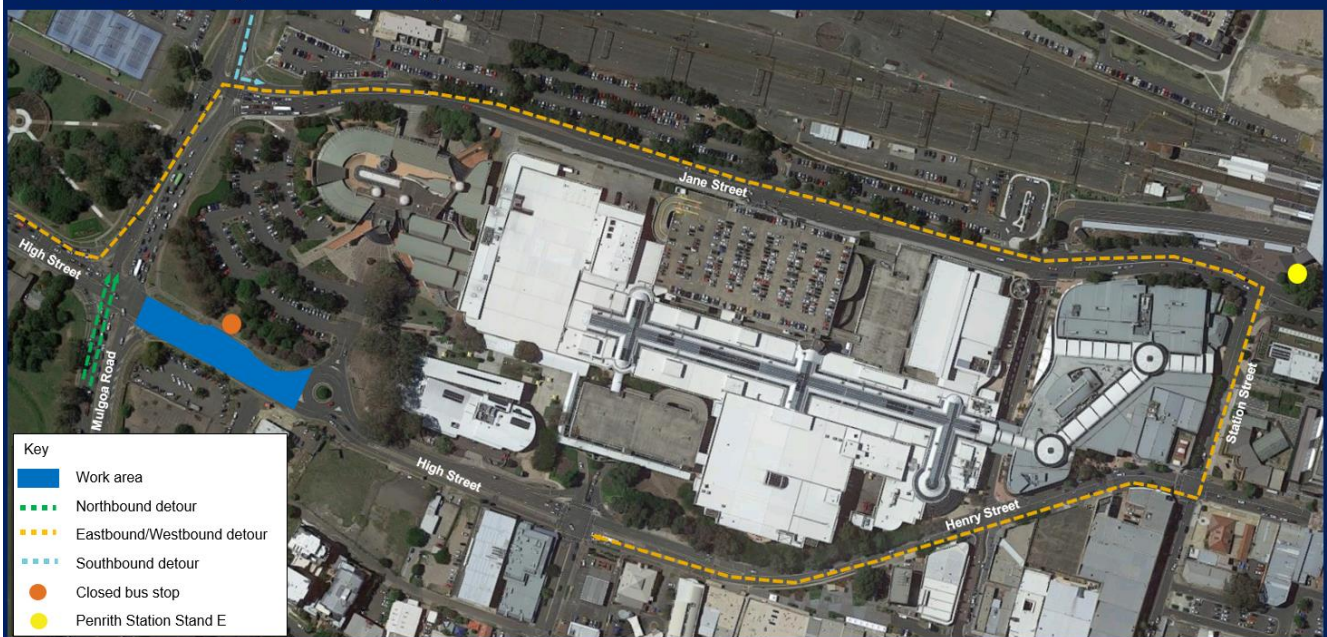

For further road construction, High Street between Mulgoa Road and Council access road will be closed for an extended night shift from **7pm Friday 26 February** to **8am Saturday 27 February 2021**, weather permitting.

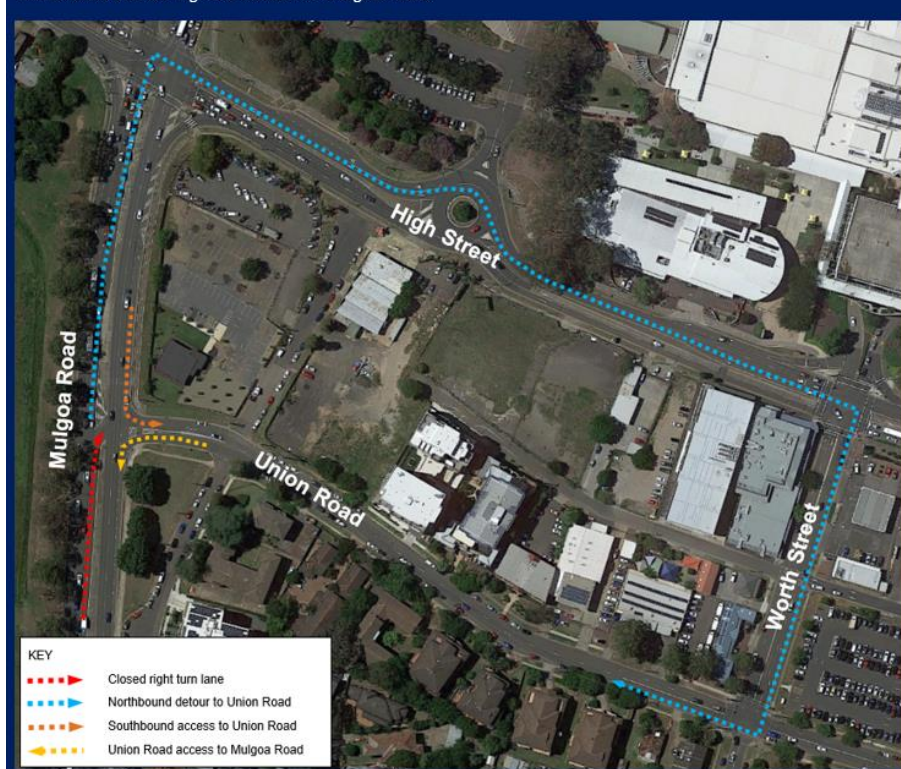
Traffic diversion during road closure – High Street



Union Road closure

To carry out pavement and median work on Mulgoa Road, right turn to access Union Road from Mulgoa Road for northbound traffic will be closed from **7pm Friday 26 February 2021** for up to four weeks. Northbound access to Union Road will be via High Street and Worth Street.

Traffic changes

During lane closures there will be traffic control and a reduced speed limit of 40 km/hr for the safety of workers, motorists, cyclists and pedestrians. For your safety please follow traffic signs.

Please follow direction of traffic controllers, speed and detour signs. All traffic changes will be temporary during our standard work hours. For the latest traffic updates call 132 701, or visit livetraffic.com.au

How will the work affect you?

Pedestrian and cyclist detours are in place on Castlereagh Road for their safety.

At times our work may be noisy. We will minimise impacts by aiming to complete noisier tasks by **11pm** and staging work in different locations.

Work in progress

The following work activities will be carried out between **Monday 1 March** and **Wednesday 31 March 2021**, weather permitting. Our work hours are Monday to Friday between **5am** and **6pm**, Saturdays **5am** to **5pm** and some nights from Monday to Sunday between **6pm** and **5am**.

- Constructing new road pavement
- Median construction
- Deliveries of equipment and materials
- Directional signage installation
- Line marking
- Footpath work and landscaping.
