Out of hours work on Nelson Bay Road, Williamtown to Bobs Farm

The NSW Government is upgrading a one-kilometre section of Nelson Bay Road, 900 metres west of Marsh Road at Salt Ash to 1.9 kilometres east of Marsh Road at Bobs Farm to dual carriageway to improve travel time and safety.

Transport for NSW has contracted Daracon to deliver this project. Work started in January 2022 and is expected to be complete in **late 2023**, weather permitting.

The project team may need to work outside the approved work hours to carry out concrete and earthwork to ensure the project is completed as efficiently as possible.

Normal work hours are between 7am to 6pm on weekdays and between 8am and 1pm on Saturday.

The project team may need to work outside of these hours on occasion for the duration of the project, between **7am** and **10pm** on **weekdays** and **7am** and **10pm** on **Saturdays**.

Out of hours work is required to ensure work is carried out as efficiently as possible and to mitigate the impact of recent wet weather on the project duration. We have included a map to show the location of the work.

How will the work affect you?

The out of hours work will involve the use of machinery that generates noise, however given the isolated work areas the work is not expected to impact nearby residents.

Nearby residents will be notified at least 24 hours in advance of any out of hours work near their property.

Traffic changes

Lane closures and traffic control will be in place during the work and may affect travel times.

There may be short term intermittent stops while a temporary 40 km/h reduced speed limit is in place through the work zones for the safety of motorists and workers.


