

## Night work on the New England Highway upgrade between Belford and the Golden Highway from Monday 30 August

The NSW Government is investing \$97 million for the upgrade to improve traffic flow, travel times and safety for motorists.

Transport for NSW has engaged ACCIONA to deliver the upgrade. To minimise impacts to motorists, some work is being carried out at night. Our night work activities will include line marking, spray sealing and installation of concrete barriers.

We will be working between **6pm to 7am** from **Monday to Friday** for **four weeks**, weather permitting.

Some work will also be carried out during our standard construction hours from Monday to Friday between 7am and 6pm and on Saturdays from 8am to 1pm.

### How will the work affect you?

The work will involve the use of machinery which generates some noise. We will make every effort to minimise noise by arranging the work in stages at different locations, completing noisier activities earlier in the night and turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use.

### Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe.

Lane closures and a 40km/h speed limit will be in place during work hours and may affect travel times. Motorists should allow up to 5 minutes extra travel time during this work.
