

# NEWCASTLE INNER CITY BYPASS: RANKIN PARK TO JESMOND ENVIRONMENTAL REPRESENTATIVE MONTHLY REPORT August 2020

Reporting Period: 1 to 31 August 2020

**PROJECT SUMMARY:** Delivery of the Newcastle Inner City Bypass (NICB) Rankin Park to Jesmond (RP2J) project has been broken into four stages:

Stage 1: Detailed design investigation and low impact works – in progress

Stage 2: Share Path Bridge – under construction

Stage 3: Southern Utilities relocation works – pre-work planning

Stage 4: Main RP2J road construction – detailed design.
