Newcastle Inner City Bypass – Rankin Park to Jesmond

Update on proposed Peatties Road compound site

The Australian and NSW Governments are funding construction of a 3.4 kilometre section of the Newcastle Inner City Bypass between Rankin Park and Jesmond, to the west of the John Hunter Hospital.

Transport for NSW has engaged Fulton Hogan to finalise the design and construct this section of the bypass.

Transport had previously proposed a site on Peatties Road at Garden Suburb for a potential compound site for the project.

Transport and Fulton Hogan has further reviewed options for their main compound site and a new location at Waratah has been selected and approved.

The site on Peatties Road will not be used for the project.

We'd like to thank the community for their patience while options were investigated, considered and approvals granted.

Next steps

Major work on the main bypass is scheduled to start in late 2022, weather permitting. We will continue to keep the community informed as work progresses.

The bypass is expected to open to traffic in 2025, weather permitting.
