

## Night work on Newcastle Road, Jesmond from Monday 10 February

The NSW Government is funding the Rankin Park to Jesmond section of the Newcastle Inner City Bypass to improve traffic flow and reduce congestion.

Transport for NSW will carry out geotechnical investigations which involves survey and utility investigations, generally in or close to the road shoulders. The investigations will provide information about the road and surrounds which will be used for project planning. We have included a map to show the location of the work.

To minimise disruption to traffic, we will be working at night between **7pm** and **5am** from **Sunday** to **Thursday** and expect to complete the work in **two weeks**, weather permitting. We will let you know in advance if we need to do any work outside these times. This work has been rescheduled from late January.

## How will the work affect you?

The work will involve the use of machinery which generates some noise. We will make every effort to minimise noise by arranging the work in stages at different locations, completing noisier activities earlier in the night and turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use.

Survey vehicles will be parked along the road with flashing lights.

Access for residents will be maintained at all times.

## Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe.

Lane closures and a 40km/h speed limit will be in place during work hours and may affect travel times.


