# **Back Creek Overtaking Lanes North of West Wyalong**

The Newell Highway Program Alliance (NHPA) is excited to announce the completion of overtaking lanes at Back Creek, about 19 kilometres north of West Wyalong. The completed work adds an additional three kilometres of northbound and southbound overtaking lanes on the Newell Highway.

The NHPA is jointly funded by the Australian Government and the NSW Government to deliver about 40 overtaking lanes over four years on the Newell Highway.

The NHPA has now completed 27 overtaking lanes





adding more than 40 kilometres of travel efficiency since it started in early 2019.

The overtaking lanes will improve safety, reduce travel times and improve freight efficiency as part of the \$1.7 billion Newell Highway upgrade.

Work on the Back Creek overtaking lanes started in November 2021 and through effective traffic management measures motorists experienced delays of less than two minutes during construction.


