



Changed traffic conditions on Brolgan Road from Monday 10 October

The Australian and NSW Governments are jointly funding the \$187.2 million Newell Highway upgrade, Parkes Bypass between Maguire Road and Barkers Road to improve connectivity, road transport efficiency and safety for local and interstate motorists.

To support pavement construction work that will enable future connections to the Hartigan Avenue extension, a 120 metre section of Brolgan Road, west of Westlime Road, will be reduced to a single lane under temporary traffic signals. We have included a map to show the location of changed traffic conditions.

Work will take place between **7am** and **6pm** from **Monday** to **Friday** and is expected to take up to **14 weeks**, weather permitting. We will let you know in advance if we need to do any work outside of these times.

Traffic changes

The work will involve the use of machinery which generates some noise. We will make every effort to minimise noise by turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use.

Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe.

Lane closures, intermittent stopping and a reduced speed limit will be in place for up to 14 weeks and may affect travel times.

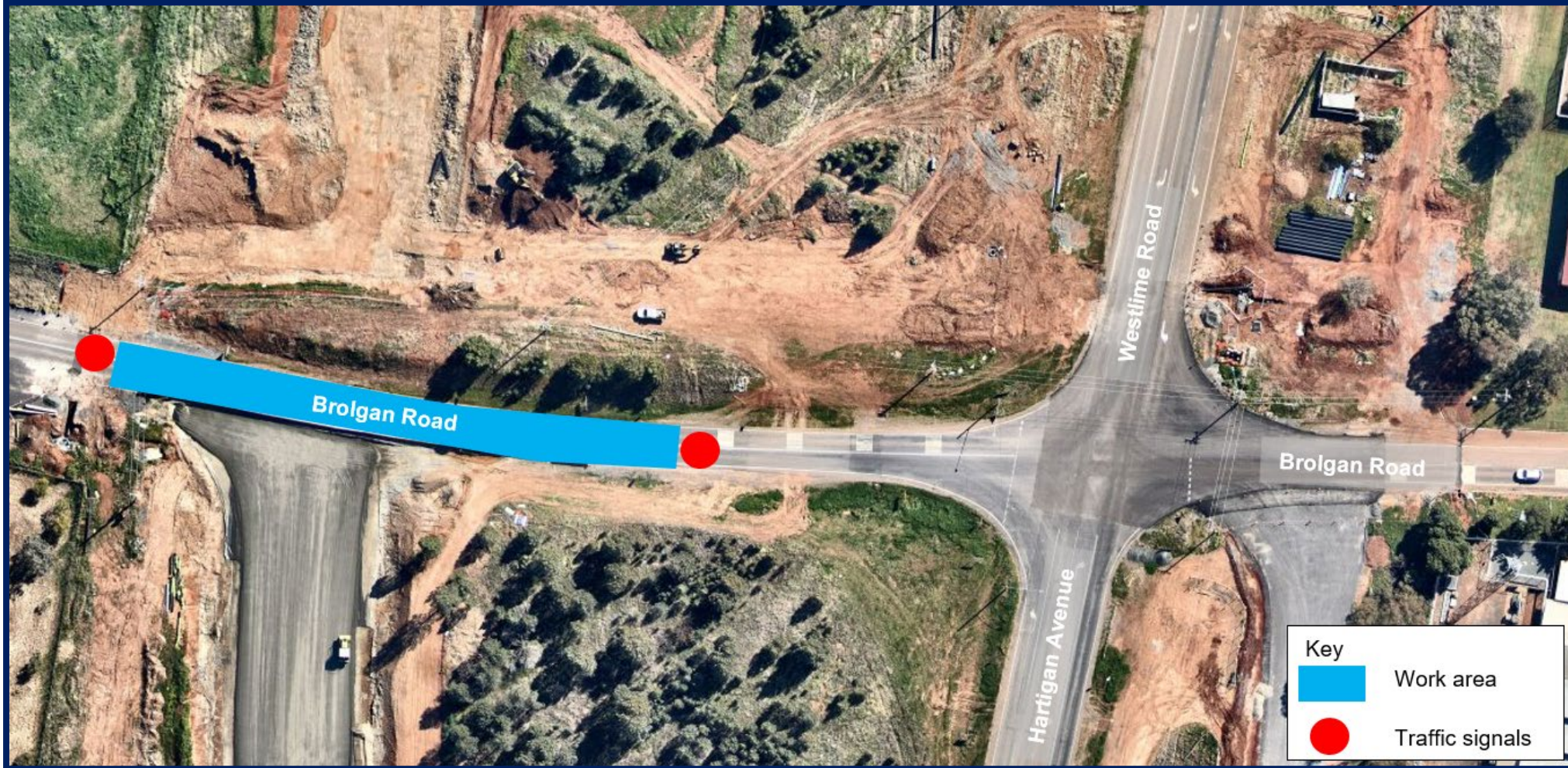
