

There are changes happening in your area: Parkes Bypass boundary fencing commences Wednesday 2 June

The Australian and NSW Governments are funding the \$187.2 million Newell Highway upgrade, Parkes Bypass to reduce travel times and improve freight productivity.



Transport for NSW will commence fencing a number of sections of the Parkes Bypass and Hartigan Avenue Extension road corridors from Wednesday 2 June. This work is part of an extensive early works program to enable main road and bridge construction of the Parkes Bypass project later in the year.

All other fencing for the Parkes Bypass will be carried out within the main Parkes Bypass construction contract.

Work will be carried out between **7am** and **6pm Monday** to **Friday** and is expected take nine weeks to complete, weather permitting.

We will let you know in advance if we need to work outside these times.

How will the work affect you?

The installation of boundary fencing north of Victoria Street will create the new Bypass road reserve and will limit east-west traffic movements across the existing Travelling Stock Route in this area. Once fencing commences there will be no vehicle access between Reedsdale Road and Bogan Road and when complete, east-west access will be available via public roads only.

Hartigan Avenue Extension road corridor and the section between London Road and Hartigan Avenue (including the bridge over rail) will also be fenced and clearly delineated to ensure safety of motorists. There will be no access for motorists in these areas.

The work will involve the use of machinery that may generate some noise during work hours. We will make every effort to minimise disruption by turning off machinery when not in use.

If this work directly affects your property access, you will hear from our project team in the coming week.
