Night work at Westlime Road and Broilgan Road intersection on Wednesday 17 August

The Australian and NSW Governments are jointly funding the \$187.2 million Newell Highway upgrade, Parkes Bypass between Maguire Road and Barkers Road to improve connectivity, road transport efficiency and safety for local and interstate motorists.

To support asphaltting work, there will be night work at the Westlime Road and Broilgan Road intersection on **Wednesday 17 August** from **6pm** to **5am**. Lane closures will be in place during the work to allow the intersection to remain open.

How will the work affect you?

The work will involve the use of machinery which may generate some noise. We will make every effort to minimise noise by arranging the work in stages at different locations and turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use.

Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe.

Lane closures, intermittent stopping and a reduced speed limit will be in place during work hours and may affect travel times.
