

Hilmer Street intersection upgrade and traffic changes from Monday 8 January 2018

The NSW Government is upgrading roads around the new Northern Beaches Hospital to increase capacity on the road network and improve access through the area

Roads and Maritime Services will upgrade the intersection of Hilmer Street and Warringah Road as part of the Northern Beaches Hospital Road Upgrade Project. This work will involve building the approach slabs for the Hilmer Street road bridge over the Warringah Road underpass.

To allow for the intersection upgrade, access into Hilmer Street from Warringah Road will be temporarily closed for up to 14 weeks from **Monday 8 January 2018**.

Some of this work will be carried out during standard construction hours between **7am and 6pm** from **Monday to Friday** and between **8am and 1pm** on **Saturday**, weather permitting.

The work will involve:

- staging road closures and temporary traffic controls for detours
- installing site fencing to delineate the work area
- constructing bridge piles in two stages
- concreting work for the substructure at the southern end of the bridge
- completing the footpath.

Due to the high volume of traffic and pedestrians in the area and to limit delays on the road network, some of the work will need to be carried out at **night** between **8pm and 5am** from Monday to Friday. Further notifications will be distributed as required.

Hilmer Street intersection upgrade

During these traffic changes motorists will be unable to enter Hilmer Street from Warringah Road. Motorists are advised to use Fitzpatrick Avenue East which is scheduled to be open from Friday 22 December 2017. Left and right turning movements out of Hilmer Street onto Warringah Road will remain.

When the work is complete, all turning movements will be reinstated allowing full access to and from Hilmer Street from Warringah Road.

A detour map has been included to show the traffic changes and alternative routes overleaf.

Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the safety of workers, motorists, cyclists and pedestrians. Lane closures or detours may be in place and will affect travel times. Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times, although minor temporary detours may be in place during the work.

How will the work affect you?

The work will involve the use of machinery which may generate some noise. We will make every effort to minimise impact by notifying the community and motorists. We will use noise shields to dampen noise where appropriate and ensure equipment and vehicles are turned off when not in use. Portable lighting will be used and we will focus lights only on the working area to minimise light spilling into nearby residences.
